Disaster Assistance

FEMA

FEMA will begin opening Disaster Recovery Centers (DRC) Friday, September 8.

Small Business Development Center & Small Business Administration

1. If you are needing **SBA Disaster Assistance** please go to the FEMA website www.disasterassistance.gov to register.
2. You can file for **SBA business** or **homeowner loans** at <https://lnkd.in/eU7rksi>. For homeowners, there are loans up to \$240K (property + contents) and for businesses (not just small) up to \$2M. Interest rates vary, but can start as low as 1.75%.
3. LSC-SBDC is coordinating with the SBA to establish a Business Recovery Center (BRC) which will serve as HUB and will be staffed with SBA personnel in addition to the SBDC staff.
